MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE ODISHA STATE HIGHER EDUCATION COUNCIL(OSHEC) HELD UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF DR. ARUN KUMAR SAHOO,HON'BLE MINISTER ,HIGHER EDUCATION AND CHAIR PERSON OF THE OSHEC ON 10.12.2019 AT 10.00AM IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF IMAGE, BHUBANESWAR

- 1. The second meeting of the Odisha State Higher Education Council was conducted under the chairmanship of the Hon'ble Minister, HED in the conference hall of IMAGE, Siripur, Bhubaneswar. The list of the members present is annexed (Annexure-I).
- 2. At the outset, VC, OSHEC welcomed the members present in the meeting. The meeting began with the self-introduction of the participants.
- 3. Apart from the nominated council members, Vice Chancellors of all other State Universities were invited to this meeting as special invitees.
- 4. VC, OSHEC briefly mentioned about the 1st Council meeting held on 20.03.2019 and presented the action taken report (Annexure- II).
- 5. VC, OSHEC mentioned about the summary of discussion of Draft National Education Policy (Higher Education) held under the auspices of OSHEC on 10.07.2019 at IMAGE, BBSR. (summary of discussions enclosed)
- 6. The Action Taken Report (ATR) was explained by VC, OSHEC wherein the reason for low response to state research fellowship was attributed to lack of Ph. D. guiding slots in universities and poor NET performance. VCs of State Universities were urged to consider keeping some fraction of Ph. D. seats for NET cleared state research fellows as well as finding a solution about the severe shortage of guides.
- 7. Some members suggested for conducting SLET in Odisha for providing better research /job opportunities in the state as well as awarding fellowships on the basis of University entrance tests. It was also suggested to increase the quantum of fellowship as well as limit of seed



- grant. Based on suggestions received and discussions, it was decided to reconsider the age limit set for OURIIP seed funding and research fellowships.
- 8. Hon'ble Minister lamented on the very less number of researchers vis-avis population in India. He pointed out that for every 10 lakh population, the number of research scholars in India is 272 whereas it is 1200 in China, 4000 in USA and France. He implored the Universities to use OURIIP to the maximum extent and motivate more and more faculty to do meaningful research.
- 9. Commissioner cum Secretary, HED indicated that to increase the usefulness of the OURIIP output in terms of addressing societal concerns, the Department may write and sensitize all government departments to suggest their research needs which, in turn, can be the focus area of next year's research.

The ATR was approved.

Agenda Item no.5: Activities to be taken up during next year

The following activities were discussed to be taken up by next year.

a. Common PG admission: It was decided that the common PG admission will be taken up to be implemented during 2020-21 academic session. As planned earlier, SAMS will be taking up the logistics support for online application for common entrance. The universities (Utkal University: Humanities, Berhampur University: Commerce and Business Administration and Sambalpur University: Science)) will indicate the timeline, model question and its pattern to OSHEC and all universities. PTC, HED and OSHEC will work together on this project of creating a state merit list for PG admissions.



- b. Incorporating the course and learning outcomes in the model UG Syllabus: the model UG syllabus published during the year needs to be supplemented with clearly specified learning and course outcomes as these will define the teaching process, lesson plans and questions in the examinations. These three activities are interconnected and OSHEC will incorporate this with the help of the Board of Studies of individual subject as before. As suggested by members, the UGC model Learning Outcome (LO) can be referred to. The work on question bank preparation would also be taken up but the details are to be discussed during the VC conclave in Session II.
- c. Incorporation of digitization into every aspect of governance is needed for HEIs to run smoothly and efficiently. In Odisha, the implementation of a common student life cycle management system, learning management system, examination management system and MIS are absolutely necessary. OSHEC would work towards facilitating this on one single platform for all State HEIs. Such a framework once installed can be used to introduce any new innovation later. This would be submitted to HED as a proposal to be implemented on O & M basis.
- d. NAAC accreditation of colleges needs to be facilitated on an urgent basis, particularly inview of the falling performances after quantitative evaluation was introduced. It is proposed to jointly work with OHEPEE project to implement Training of Trainers who will later guide the colleges as mentors. The program envisages developing a group of trainers who will work with the colleges as mentors up to their NAAC accreditation,
- e. The members were informed that the council website hosting is in progress and the demo was projected in the meeting. NIC, Bhubaneswar is developing the website and gradually the required information and data are being fed.



- f. As scheduled in the OURIIP Scheme, it is proposed to hold annual review of work under the aegis of Odisha Research Conclave that will include the OURIIP schemes and the Centre of Excellences (COEs) of OHEPEE. It was also proposed to raise the eligibility age of the faculty from 40 to 45 years for seed fund research project and State research fellows from 30 to 35 years due to the specific circumstances in the state.
- g. On a reference to creating specialized multidisciplinary research laboratories in the state by VC, GMU, it was suggested that the COEs have been established with exactly this objective in mind. VCs of all state universities were requested to kindly facilitate and monitor the sustainability plan of each COE.
- h. Commissioner-cum-Secretary requested all the VCs to consolidate what is happening in the university. He preferred consolidation of on-going good practices rather than initiating new things.
- a. A number of issues including Industry-Academia linkage (VC, RDWU and Dr.(Er.) Dibakar Swain), appointment of faculty in colleges and urgent governance changes (Prof. KK Basa), Reforms not reaching the grass root level (Dr. Roshnara Begum), SU taking up significant research areas to help the society (VC, SU) and strengthening the libraries and Laboratories of State Universities and Colleges (VC, OSHEC) were raised. Hon'ble Minister as well as Commissioner cum Secretary addressed most of these issues at the core level and detailed the actions being taken by the Department. It was said that the existing e-resources would continue and Universities those are not in the list will be added.
- j. Commissioner-cum-Secretary discussed the concept of adapting MOOCs and virtual tutorial (RUSA1.0) to undergraduate curriculum as this is the way for the future. He suggested that we should develop good quality econtent by engaging good faculty.

He suggested that the e-content being developed under RUSA must be reviewed before taking a decision.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks by the Member Secretary.
